Diede will discuss the impact of rain on fuels and how we might be in for a serious wildfire threat once the summer and fall arrive.
4. **History Presentation: The Woolsey Fire (NOV 8 - 21 2018)** - A wildfire that burned through Los Angeles and Ventura Counties - burning 96,949 acres, killing three people, and destroying 1,643 buildings. LAFD Assistant Chief S. Tomlinson will discuss the basics of structure defense, as he was involved with protecting homes during the Woolsey fire.
5. **Hot Topics** including “Are we out of the drought?” - “What steps do I take to join the alliance?” - “How do I start a Fire Safe Council in my neighborhood?”
